Works notification | 8 April 2024

## **Pest control activities on Saturday 13 April 2024 from 10pm**

On Saturday 13 April, pest control activities will occur at Hurlstone Agricultural High School to control the population of red foxes on the site.

Sydney Feral and Commercial Pest Control Pty Ltd have been engaged to undertake this work, which will be done using firearms. The work will take place from 10pm, using subsonic ammunition and silencers to minimise disruption to the community.

This work will take place in accordance with the [Department of Primary Industries](#) guidelines and relevant legislation. The local police will be notified at the commencement and completion of works. This work has scheduled during school holidays to minimise disruption to school operations and ensure safety.
